

## Session Highlights - April 26, 2010

The April 26 Session meeting began with a Read, Reflect and Respond discussion of the parable of the prodigal son led by Fred Vant Slot and David McBee from the Discipleship Council.

The Discipleship Council made a presentation on the Council's goals for 2010-11. The goals were developed using PHPC's Vision relating to education. Fred Vant Slot and David McBee of the Children's Ministry Team emphasized the partnership of the leadership team, teachers and parents in building a foundation for the children of PHPC. New programs planned for this summer are Camp PVN and Passport to Mexico. PHPC's youth will be traveling to Scotland and Northern Ireland the summer. A goal of the Adult Ministry team is to explore the use of technology in the creation of a web-based PHPC online Christian education program.

Russell Jonas led a discussion focused on a leader self-assessment and setting individual goals.

Trey Angel, Church Financial Officer, reported that cash receipts are 2% favorable to the budget, and spending continues to be below forecast. PHPC's reserves approximate four months of operating expenses.

Bill Davis reported the Congressional Nominating Committee has closed nominations for the officer class of 2013.

Dr. Monie reported the searches for the Executive Associate Pastor and the Lilly pastoral intern continue to progress.
